Walking In The World

Uranus, master planet of surprises, has been moving slowly retrograde (backwards) through Pisces since the middle of May. This could help explain why you've felt erratic or impatient, or why your path has taken sudden turns. Basically, Uranus brings chaos out of which a new life is formed. Initially, you may be upset by changes that threaten the way life is now, but it's always better to go with the flow under a powerful Uranus transit.

The good news is that Uranus goes direct again on November 20, which could bring clarity about certain matters that have been driving your mind crazy. Uranus is called the great awakener, and the chaos he brings actually serves to wake up your higher consciousness – to lift your soul from slumber. It's a very spiritual time for you, dear Pisces, so focus on creating a strong connection with your higher self, or with the Divine. This will help you navigate through Uranus-style surprises with greater confidence.

Remind yourself daily that you have all the resources you need to meet challenges and cope with change. Try to welcome in the new – for it won't go away. I'm not saying you are a victim of fate, just that adapting will work better than resistance.



Relationships

There are two eclipses this spring. One occurs in your relationship zone, and one directly opposite. The effects of eclipses

can take time to reveal themselves, so pay careful attention to news or events that change your understanding of yourself and your partner.

The first eclipse is an eclipse of the Moon on September 8. This occurs when the Moon reaches its fullness in Pisces. It's likely to reveal something about yourself and your love life that is very important. Though you may feel upset to begin with, take heart from knowing that eclipses tend to set you off in a better direction. If your partner dissolves into tears or starts acting strangely, take the time to explore what's happening between you. If you were born on March 5, 6 or 7, this eclipse could bring a very significant change.

The second eclipse is an eclipse of the Sun in Virgo on September 22, smack in the middle of your relationship zone! A gloomy mood or sense of foreboding can arise with solar eclipses. You might lose faith in your partnership or question whether it's right for you. Identify the fears and feelings that come to light at this time, and again, give them your attention. Talk things through and don't hide. This is an especially significant time for Pisceans born on March 18, 19 or 20.

If you're single, your best times for meeting someone new this spring are around September 7 or 19. September 26 could see arguments or conflict boiling up as Venus squares Pluto. Don't let yourself be bullied.
